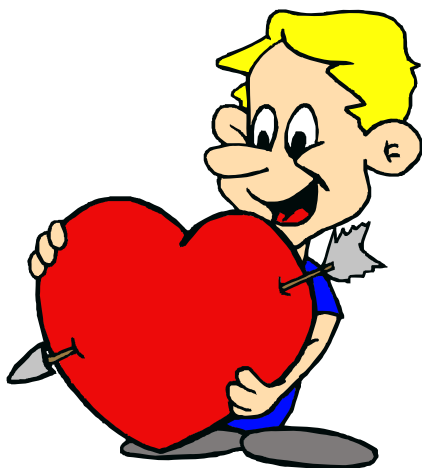

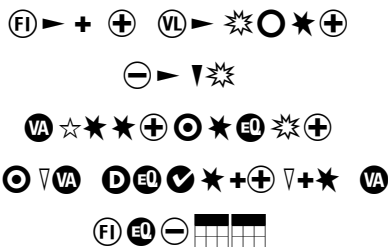

Manitowoc Bylaw Changes to Reflect Wisconsin Jaycees Membership Rules Change:

Article II – Membership and Dues (Old bylaws in normal font; New bylaws in italics)

Section 3. Any member whose dues are in arrears for a period of four (4) months shall automatically cease to be a member, provided the Membership Vice President of this corporation has served notice of this fact at least thirty (30) days before the end of the four (4) month period. Any member who becomes delinquent for a period of one (1) month shall be assessed a late fee of \$5.00. Any member who becomes delinquent for a period in excess of three (3) months shall have the privilege of becoming reinstated upon payment of the amount of dues then owing, including the late fee of \$5.00.

Section 4. Notice of dues owing shall be given the members by the Membership Vice-President in writing and/or verbally forty-five and thirty (45/30) days before date payable. The Membership Vice-President shall contact any members whose dues are in arrears for a period of thirty (30) days. Any unpaid dues within ninety (90) days of renewal month will be subject to late fees as stated in Section 3. (As amended July 1995.)

Section 3. Notice of dues owing shall be given to the members by the Membership Vice-President. Renewals are due to the chapter by the 15th of the month prior to the renewal month. Meeting this, the \$45 renewal rate will apply. From the 16th to the last Thursday in the month prior to the renewal month, the \$50 renewal rate will apply. If dues are not paid by the last Thursday in the month prior to the renewal month, new member status will apply.
