Hello Manitowoc Jaycees!

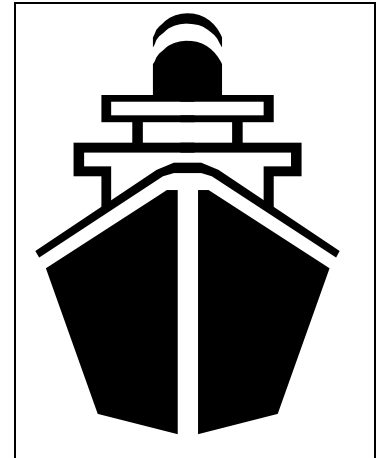
