Sep. 7th – 8pm

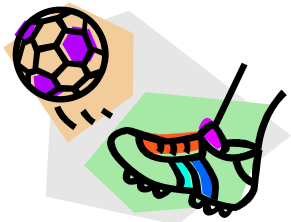
Sep. 14th – 6pm
