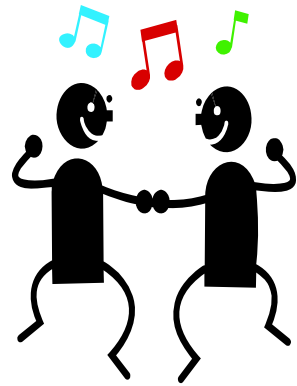
**Deaf Awareness Project – May 19, 2007 - 8:00 AM to 12:00 PM
