July: What is one freedom you take for granted and how would you change your ways?

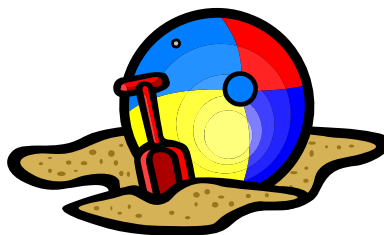
