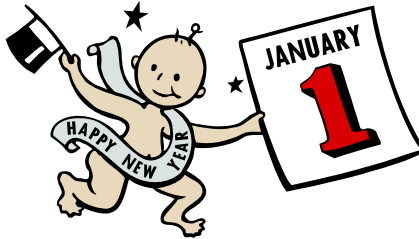

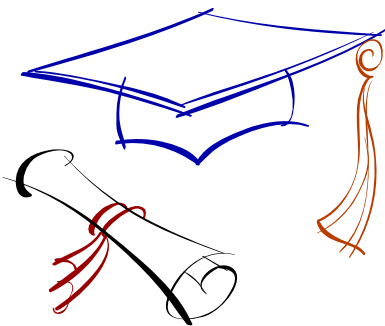

Y Weight?

Is getting fit one of your New Year's resolutions? Do you thrive on a challenge? Are you interested in teaming up with the Jaycees to meet your goal? If enough members are interested, the Manitowoc Jaycees are planning to participate in the Y Weight Challenge being held by the YMCA January 21st – March 30th. We will break into teams of three to five members, depending on how many members sign up. Each week of the 10 week program, you will be receiving fitness and nutritional advice via email or by attending scheduled events aimed at keeping you motivated through the fitness challenge. Teams also receive personal training sessions with a certified trainer. Cost is \$15 per person for the challenge, \$20 if you'd like a t-shirt. You need to be available on Saturday, January 21st for a Pre-test and March 30th for a Post-test. You do not need to be a Y member to sign up for this challenge. They will be offering 10 free passes to registered team members and a card which you can purchase for \$30 for 30 visits to the Y if you do not have access to exercise equipment.
